



FURTHER ORDERED: Petition to Amend Civil Rules 5.2 and 80; Criminal Rules 1.6, 17.1, and 41; Civil Appellate Rule 4.2; Family Court Rules 20, 40, 45, and 97; Justice Court Civil Rule 113; Juvenile Rule 105; and Supreme Court Rule 1, Form 1 (Expedited Consideration and Emergency Adoption Requested Pursuant to Rule 28) = ADOPTED on an emergency basis, effective immediately.
